

## IDA Program for Afghan Evacuees

The Individual Development Account program helps participants achieve their financial goals through classes in personal financial management and an individual savings plan.



**Goals:** Rental Assistance, Microloans for Small Businesses, Vocational Training, Job Recertification and Further Education

**Savings Grants Amounts:** Families who qualify for Rental Assistance will receive up to \$1,000 per month with a maximum of \$12,000 per year per household

OR

Families and individuals saving for Microenterprise or Small Businesses, Vocational Training, Recertification or Further Education will receive a 1-to-1 match or \$4,000 for families or \$2,000 for individuals

**Seminars and 1-on-1 instruction:**

These workshops teach the basics of money and financial management for New Americans to help you reach your financial goals.

**Who Qualifies:**

Afghan Asylees, Parolees, and SIVs who entered the US after July 2021

For Rental Assistance: proof of income is not required

For those saving for Microenterprise, Vocational Training, Recertification or Further Education: proof of income and 1-to-1 match from savings is required
