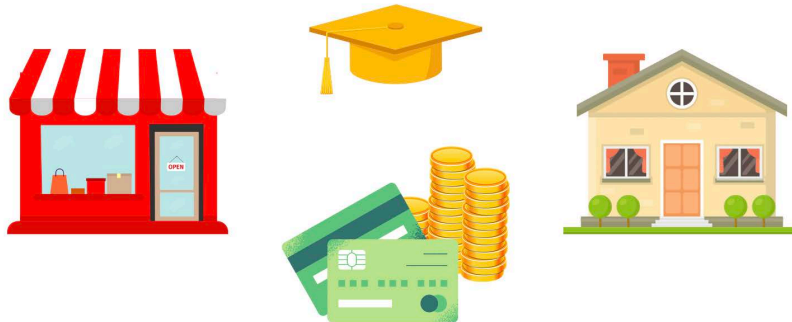


IDA Program

The Individual Development Account program helps participants achieve their financial goals through classes in personal financial management and an individual savings plan.



Goals: Microenterprise Development, Vocational Training, Job Recertification, Further Education, and Homeownership.

To Enroll a 1-to-1 savings plan agreement and proof of income is required.

Who Qualifies: Refugees, Asylees, Afghan and Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees, Afghan and Iraqi SIVs, among others.

Assets may not exceed \$10,000 at time of enrollment and household income must not exceed:

Applicants who are not yet citizens and do not exceed 5 years in the United States at the time of enrollment.
